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Everyone has had the occasion of sitting at table with people with whom they share a complicated life story. What if someone with whom we are sharing a meal turns out to

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be our enemy? What if we like that person, even just a little, before we find out who they really are? Do we confront them? Do we forgive them? Lidia and Sandra have not yet asked themselves these questions. For the time being they are happy to be able to meet up after so many years without seeing each other, introduce themselves to their respective boyfriends and reminisce about old times. But the evening doesn't go according to plan. One small detail changes everything, and problems ensue.

In 2023 Teatr Nowy celebrated in Poznan (Poland) the centenary of its creation. In its recent history, this company, one of the longest-running and most prestigious in the world, has been in constant operation as a public cultural institution for 50 years, has had exclusive directors and has staged more than 250 productions. It currently has a regular line-up of 24 plays, including classical and contemporary ones, drama and musicals, large multi-stage productions and chamber plays featuring artists representing different generations, like the audiences who attend the shows.
